TYPES OF PARTICIPANTS

At the **China Youth Summit**, participants can join under the following categories:

1 Regular Participant

- Individuals who register directly through the official website.
- Registration can be under the **Self-Funded** or **Fully Funded** scheme.

2 Ambassador

- Youth who apply before the official registration opens and are selected to **promote the program**.
- Ambassadors receive **special benefits**, including a chance for free registration, by completing targeted tasks and content promotion.
- They also guide new participants by sharing step-by-step information on the registration process.
- Registration can be under the **Self-Funded** or **Fully Funded** scheme.

3 Partnership

- Participants registered through **partner institutions** (schools, universities, or organizations).
- Institutions send participants to represent their name at an international level.
- Registration can be under the **Self-Funded** or **Fully Funded** scheme.

4 Guardians

- Parents or guardians accompanying participants under 18 years old to ensure smooth travel and immigration processes.
- Special packages are provided for guardians.

TYPES OF REGISTRATION SCHEME

Participants may join under two financial schemes:

1 Fully Funded Scheme

- a. Provided through a competitive selection process, which includes:
 - o Registration form & required documents
 - o Essay submission
 - o Interview assessment
- Notes : Only the strongest candidates will be awarded fully funded status.**
- b. Program Fee Policy for Fully Funded Delegates
 - Fully Funded Delegates **are not required to pay the program fee**. However, **delegates who request visa-supporting documents** (such as a hotel booking confirmation, guarantee letter, or invitation letter) **before the Fully Funded interview stage or interview announcement must pay the Program Fee (Batch 1)** for document processing and administrative support.
 - c. Reimbursement System
 - Delegates who have paid the **Program Fee (Batch 1)** for visa-related purposes will receive reimbursement if selected as **Fully Funded Delegates**; if not selected, the payment will continue under the **Self-Funded scheme**.
 - d. Declaration Letter Policy
 - Applicants who receive an **official interview invitation** will be required to sign and submit a **Declaration Letter** before the interview is scheduled. Failure to submit the letter may result in **disqualification from the Fully Funded selection**.
 - e. Additional Opportunity
 - Selected Fully Funded Delegates may serve as **moderators in panel discussions alongside expert speakers**.

2 Self Funded Scheme

- For those who prefer to **skip the selection process** and secure their participation directly.
- Also applies to applicants who were not selected as fully funded — they will automatically be considered **Self-Funded Participants** once they are not receiving any email for interview or is rejected for an interview.
- Self Funded participants who at first have applied in Fully Funded scheme and got rejected, can confirm their participation without having to re-register or pay an additional registration fee.
- Only the **program fee/installments** need to be completed.
- **Program fees** paid by Self-Funded Delegates are **non-refundable** if the delegate withdraws or does not continue the process.

HOW TO REGISTER

Before you start please pay attention:

- For the best experience, open the website on a laptop and use incognito/private browsing to avoid issues during updates or bugs.
- Have a non-institutional email (Gmail, Yahoo, etc.), a photo/ID ready, and your essay (if applying for fully funded).

Registration Steps

- 1 Open the website**
Go to chinayouthsummit.com (or the official registration page provided)
- 2 Choose a registration type**
Select Self-Funded or Fully-Funded depending on the registration period and your preference.
- 3 Create your account**
 - Enter your full name and an active email address (personal email recommended).
 - Create a strong password you can remember.
 - Click Sign Up to register your account.
- 4 Sign in**
After signing up, log in with the email and password you just created.
- 5 Check your dashboard**
On the dashboard you will see your registration status (Self-Funded or Fully-Funded) and whether your submission form is complete.
- 6 Open the Submission form**
Go to Submission → Edit Submission and complete these sections:
 - Personal details
 - Professional profile
 - Entry information
 - Miscellaneous (includes essay upload and theme selection)
- 7 The essay and theme selection are used to place you into a project group if your participation is confirmed.**
- 8 Review carefully**
Double-check every field before saving. Save & continue as you progress.
- 9 Preview & Payment**
 - Go to the Preview section to review your entire submission.
 - Proceed to Make Payment (if applicable) and wait until payment status shows Success.
- 10 Final submission**
After payment shows Success, return to Submission and click Submit to complete your registration.

Important Notes & Differences

- You may edit your form after payment only if you have not clicked the final Submit button. Once submitted, the form cannot be changed.
- Fully-Funded applicants:
 - Additional requirements apply (complete required pages and share campaign assets on social media — e.g., twibbon). These sharing steps are mandatory for fully funded applicants.
- Self-Funded applicants:
 - Essay submission is not required.
 - Social sharing (twibbon, etc.) is not required.
 - The rest of the form still needs to be completed and paid (if applicable).

HOW TO MAKE PAYMENT

1 Go to the Payment tab

- Open your dashboard and click on the Payment tab. You will see your payment details, including payment history, pending payments, and cancelled payments.

2 Check your payment information

- Review which payment you want to make — either the Registration Fee or an Installment Fee.
- The installment option will appear based on the active period and will display the deadline for when the payment is due.

Essay requirements

- Maximum 800 words
- Written in English
- Theme: Choose only one SDG focus
- Include data where relevant (with citation)

What makes a strong essay?

1. Clear structure
2. Strong arguments
3. Reflection on challenges
4. Realistic and scalable solutions

What we are looking for?

1. Clear understanding of a real problem
2. Critical thinking
3. Youth-led action
4. Sustainable solution (not one-time event)
5. Measurable impact

RECOMMENDED STRUCTURE

1	Introduction Begin with a concise introduction. Briefly introduce the issue within your chosen SDG and explain why it matters in your context. Clearly state your main argument: how a youth-driven initiative can move beyond short-term solutions and create long-term social and economic sustainability. You may briefly mention your project or area of focus, but avoid lengthy background narratives. Keep the introduction focused and purposeful.
2	Problem Context Describe the current condition in your community or country and identify the gap that needs to be addressed. Why is this issue urgent? What existing solutions are insufficient? If possible, support your explanation with relevant data. This section should demonstrate that you understand the issue beyond surface-level observation.
3	Initiative / Experience Explain what you have done (or are currently doing), and clearly define your role. Describe the challenges you encountered and how you addressed them. We are particularly interested in your leadership, decision-making process, and problem-solving ability. Avoid general claims; be specific about actions and outcomes.
4	Sustainability and Long-Term Strategy Explain how your initiative moves beyond a one-time event or short-term intervention. What makes it sustainable? Consider factors such as partnerships, funding models, community involvement, policy alignment, scalability, or systems change. Demonstrate how your project generates both social impact and economic value over time.
5	Project Proposal Include times and expected outcomes related to your subtopic.

ESSAY EXAMPLE

HOPE: Empowering Youth to Transform Education, Inclusion, and Neurodiversity Awareness Globally

Education is often called the most powerful tool to change the world, yet many children remain excluded, misunderstood, or underserved, particularly those with neurological differences or learning challenges. As youth, we have the unique ability to understand the struggles of our peers, identify gaps in the system, and design solutions that are both innovative and deeply human. HOPE (Helping Others Pursue Empowerment), the initiative I founded, is a living example of how youth-led projects can address challenges in Quality Education (SDG 4) while creating lasting community impact.

In our culture, children with neurological conditions are often burdened by stigma, myths, and superstitions, with families sometimes believing they are “bad karma.” This marginalization affects not only their access to education but also their self-esteem and social inclusion. HOPE was created to challenge these beliefs, foster understanding, and provide practical support. Through campaigns, workshops, and school programs, HOPE has reached over 500 students and educators, teaching them to recognize potential rather than limitations. By cultivating empathy and awareness, these programs have helped children with autism and other special needs feel seen, valued, and included in their educational environment.

HOPE’s digital platforms have been essential in scaling impact globally. Our podcast channel has reached listeners in 15 countries, while our Instagram page has garnered over 21,000 views, sharing stories, interviews, and resources about neurodiversity. Our blog series documents experiences and actionable tips for educators, parents, and peers, amplifying the voices of children who are often overlooked. Through these platforms, HOPE has inspired youth worldwide to engage actively in inclusion initiatives, turning awareness into action.

Beyond awareness, HOPE has partnered with leading organizations to provide tangible support for neurodiverse learners. Collaborations with Samarthanam and Tribes for Good have enabled us to distribute audiobooks and accessible educational resources for visually impaired and specially-abled children. I was also honored to be selected as an in-person delegate to represent HOPE at IYC12, a program in partnership with the United Nations, bringing our advocacy to a global stage. This opportunity allowed us to share HOPE’s model, inspire other youth-led initiatives, and expand our network of collaborators.

HOPE's commitment to evidence-based strategies has led to engagements with experts and academics, including the Policy Strategist at Autism Society Alberta and professors researching autism at Yale and UCLA. These interactions have enriched our programs with practical insights and research-backed approaches, ensuring our initiatives are sustainable and impactful. By combining community-level action with global insights, HOPE exemplifies how youth-led projects can create long-term, meaningful change.

The strength of HOPE lies in peer engagement. When young people lead, their peers listen, participate, and become advocates themselves. This ripple effect amplifies awareness and inclusion, spreading from schools to communities and even influencing policy discussions. Over time, initiatives like HOPE not only improve educational access and equity but also foster a culture of empathy, respect, and empowerment that endures beyond the immediate programs.

Ultimately, HOPE demonstrates that youth-led initiatives addressing Quality Education are not just about improving access to resources—they are about changing mindsets. By celebrating diversity, challenging misconceptions, and providing practical tools for learning, HOPE ensures that children with neurodiverse needs can thrive academically, socially, and emotionally. Every podcast listener, social media follower, or workshop participant represents a step toward a more inclusive, understanding, and equitable educational landscape.

In conclusion, initiatives like HOPE illustrate how passion, creativity, and youth leadership can transform education. By identifying challenges, implementing solutions, and engaging both local and global communities, HOPE ensures quality, inclusive, and equitable education for all. Beyond statistics or programs, it embodies a movement of empathy, action, and hope, showing that when youth lead with purpose, they can change not only individual lives but entire communities.

REGISTRATION UPDATE AND COMMUNICATION

Here are the things that every participant should pay attention to after completing their registration:

01 Wait for Your Form Review

After submitting your registration form, please wait while the selection team reviews your submission. Once validated and accepted, you will receive a Letter of Acceptance (LoA).

02 Understanding Your LoA

- Receiving an LoA means your form has been verified and accepted by the committee.
- For Self-Funded participants, the LoA confirms that your registration is complete and valid.
- For Fully-Funded applicants, **the LoA does not yet mean you are accepted as a fully-funded delegate**. It indicates that your form has passed the first review stage and will proceed to the Essay Review and Interview Selection process.

03 Where to Access Your LoA

- The LoA will be sent to your registered email address and can also be downloaded from the "Documents" tab on your account dashboard.

04 Documents Provided After Receiving the LoA

Once your LoA is issued, you will have access to several documents to download, sign, and share:

- **Agreement Letter:**

This outlines program policies and serves as an agreement between participants and the organizer. It confirms your commitment to participate from registration until the end of the program. Download, sign, and upload this document again under the Documents tab in your account.

- **Sponsorship Proposal Template:**

Provided for participants who wish to seek external funding (from companies, organizations, or communities) to support their journey to the event. You may customize it according to your needs and budget.

- **Program Boarding Pass:**

A digital card to share on your social media as part of the official China Youth Summit exposure campaign. It helps boost excitement and awareness about your participation.

05 How to Stay Updated During the Selection Process

While waiting for the LoA or selection results (sent in batches), please stay connected and updated through these official channels:

- The official website and social media platforms of China Youth Summit.
- Regular updates sent to your registered email (newsletters and important notices).
- Pre-Orientation Sessions announced on social media, held via Zoom and Instagram Live.

06 Official Group Invitation

The official participant group will only be opened and accessible to those who have made at least their first installment payment of the program fee.

07 Fully-Funded Participants — Confirmation of Attendance
